WE CANNOT ACCEPT

FABRIC that is stained, worn, wadded, mildewed, frayed, in thin strips, has pet hair, or with patterns pinned on

YARN in balls or strands

POLYFILL

VINYL, RUBBER

Anything with **PINS** in it

PATTERNS

MAGAZINES

CLOTHING, whole or parts.

Exceptions: Saris, kimonos, ethnic, vintage

CURTAINS, SLIPCOVERS

BED & TABLE LINENS

UNFINISHED PROJECTS

Exceptions: quilts or old needlework examples

FABRIC: Yardage (at least 1/2 yard) is preferred, but flat and folded fat quarters or similar small pieces are welcome. Quilting scraps are okay, if they are flat. Please do not donate wrinkled or wadded fabric of any size.

VINTAGE MATERIALS: Vintage fabric, machines, and sewing/needlecraft notions are welcome. We use older materials in our education efforts, and to honor the long tradition of needlework and the beauty of everyday objects.
