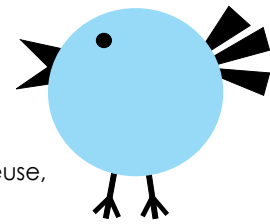

Dear Anna:

Welcome to SewGreen's **2010 Summer Teen Program!** Here are some important reminders.

LOCATION: The program will be held at our new classroom, in Clinton Hall at 112 North Cayuga Street in Ithaca. The space is the one closest to the yellow awning. Look for the big green birdie!

DATES & TIMES: The core program runs for six weeks, from **July 12 through August 19**. During that time, will meet every **Monday through Thursday, from noon to 5 pm**. The Summer Showcase will be held on Friday, August 20, from 3 to 6 pm. On that day, we will meet at 10 am.

OPTIONAL WORK HOURS: You will be invited to apply to help teach childrens' classes, at the end of the summer. The classes will be held August 23 through 26, noon to 4 pm; and August 30 through September 2, noon to 4 pm. The teaching stipend is \$80 per week. If you think you will enjoy this work, save the dates.

JOB PLACEMENT: If you qualify, you may be able to attend the SewGreen program as a paid worker through a youth employment service such as JobLink or the YES program at the Ithaca Youth Bureau. If you have not pursued this option, you should do so **immediately**. SewGreen will assist you as much as possible, but making the initial connections is up to you. If you want to be paid, you must contact the Ithaca Youth Bureau **by June 4** to find out if you qualify or to get a referral to another agency that can help.

ATTENDANCE & PUNCTUALITY: We expect that you will make a strong effort to attend the program every day, and to arrive on time and stay for the entire afternoon. You must inform us in advance if you need to be excused for illness, appointments, or family obligations.

FOOD: We always have ample refreshments, but we advise bringing a lunch or snacks. Please note any food allergies on the enclosed contact form.

TRANSPORTATION: You must arrange for your own transportation to and from SewGreen, but if a lack of safe transportation would keep you from coming to the program, let us know. We may be able to help.

EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM: Please bring the completed form, enclosed, to the first day of the program.

YOUR CREATIVITY: We're interested in your interests! We invite you to bring sewing, crafts, or art projects you've made, or pictures, drawings, ideas, books, materials, tools — whatever will help us know more about your particular creative direction, inspiration, or wishes.
